CHARGES:

Conspiracy, §97-1-1 (count 1)
Voter Fraud, §23-15-753 (count 2)

THE GRAND JURORS of the State of Mississippi, taken from the body of good and lawful citizens of said County and State aforesaid, duly elected, empaneled, sworn and charged to inquire in and for said County and State aforesaid, at the aforesaid term of said County and State, in the name and by the authority of the State of Mississippi, upon their oaths present that:

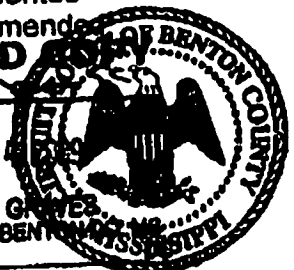
COUNT 1 [Conspiracy]

Clinton Moffitt, Lillie Jean Norton and Ada Moore Tucker, in Benton County, Mississippi (hereinafter "county"), and within the jurisdiction of the court, on or about July 1, 2007 and continuing through August 7, 2007, in violation of M.C.A. §97-1-1 annotated as amended, did wilfully, unlawfully and feloniously conspire and agree with each other to commit the crime of voter fraud by procuring and seeking to influence the absentee vote of individuals by the payment of money in an effort to influence their vote in the August 7, 2007, Primary Election, in which the said Clinton Moffitt was a candidate for sheriff of Benton County, Mississippi, the object of said conspiracy being a violation of M.C.A. §23-15-753 annotated as amended;

COUNT 2 [Voter Fraud]

Clinton Moffitt, Lillie Jean Norton and Ada Moore Tucker, in Benton County, Mississippi (hereinafter "county"), and within the jurisdiction of the court on or about July 13, 2007, did wilfully, unlawfully, and feloniously procure and seek to influence the absentee vote of Catina Taylor by the payment of money; in that Clinton Moffitt, Lillie Jean Norton and Ada Moore Tucker offered to pay Catina Taylor \$20.00 in order for her to vote by absentee ballot for the said Moffitt who was a candidate for sheriff of Benton County, Mississippi, in the August 7, 2007, Primary Election, and after she voted by absentee ballot she did receive \$20.00, in violation of M.C.A. §23-15-753 annotated as amended.

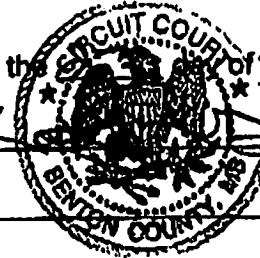
