I Shundarell Johnson, am writing to ask for your help.

This letter is to support my clemency application. I am asking for a second chance for a fresh start.

I was incarcerated in Rankin County for an aggravated assault charge.

The incident happened in 2004. I was sentenced in 2007 of September, 15 years, 10 suspended, 5 to serve and

3 probation. I did not serve the whole 5 years. I came home on Early Release Sentence.

I have learned from my mistake and I am sorry for what I did.

I am not a trouble maker or a violent person. I stay to myself. I am 33 years old with

3 children. It is very hard for me to support my family, and its hard for me to find a job

because of my aggravated assault charge on my record. I have been looking for a job and it seems impossible. Since I been home, I've enrolled in Virginia College as a Medical Assistant Student and will be finish in Septembe 2011 an will be receiving a diploma in Associates Degree in February 2012. Upon on finishing school I will have to do an externship and I'm afraid with my aggravated assault I will not be able to complete the program or find a job in my field. I have already completed my G.E.D. and was a Certified Nursing Assistant before I went in. I have learned my lesson and I am trying to rebuild my life for my kids and myself. My future depends on this clemency being granted because in future reference I want to further my education in becoming a pediatric nurse and I am trying to join the Army Reserved. I was told that you are the person I need to talk to about granting a clemency for

a pardon. I pray that you take in consideration: my good behavior, positive attitude, that this was my first offense and that I am trying to be a productive citizen. I apologize for the mistake I made in 2004 and I am a better person. I thank you in advance for taking the time to read my letter.

Continuation, Narrative and Witness Statement

On February 8, 2004 at 1634 I, Detective Amos Clinton IBM 1190 was met at the Robbery/Homicide Office by Ms. Danielle Robinson. Ms. Robinson stated that she stepped outside her residence about to leave for work, when she noticed Ms. Shundarell Johnson hiding in the brushes next to her house. Ms. Robinson stated that she started walking back towards the house to tell her boyfriend, Shocoby Jones that he needed to tell Ms. Shundarell Johnson to leave her residence, but before she made it inside the house, Ms. Johnson attacked her with a knife. Ms. Robinson stated that she fought Ms. Johnson for awhile after being stabbed with the knife, then her boyfriend Shocoby Jones came out of the house and tried to stop Ms. Johnson from attacking her. Ms. Robinson stated that Shocoby was able to take the knife from Ms. Johnson, as they continued to fight. Ms. Robinson stated that she tried to go into the house and this was when Ms. Johnson stabbed her in the back with a second knife that she had. Ms. Robinson stated that once they were inside the house fighting her brother, Benjamin Barnes and her sister Leslie Barnes ran out of their bedroom and tried to take the second knife from Ms. Johnson. Ms. Robinson stated that she had her hand on the second knife and so did her brother, so she let the knife go and this was when Ms. Johnson stabbed her in the chest before her relatives were able to hold Ms. Johnson until officers arrived on scene.

Ms. Johnson was transported to the Robbery/Homicide Office, where she refused to give detectives a statement after she was advised of her Miranda Rights. Ms. Johnson was transported to the city jail for the charge of Aggravated Assault. Officer did recover the weapon used in this crime, which was logged into evidence at Precinct 2. Ms. Robinson stated that the reason this incident occurred is because, Ms. Johnson was upset over Shocoby Jones having her child in her present and she is jealous over their relationship. A witness location form, and statement was logged into evidence at the Robbery/Homicide Office.
